Music students playing at a pre-orchestral level will participate in rehearsal workshops with HSO Artistic Director Oliver Balaburski. They will then join the entire Huronia Symphony to rehearse.

On **Sunday, February 10**, the Huronia Symphony Youth Program participants will combine with the HSO to play a youth version of the first movement from Beethoven's famous Fifth Symphony. They will also join the audience to enjoy the HSO performance of works such as the Overture to *The Barber of Seville*, Themes from *Harry Potter*, and Selections from the *Phantom of the Opera*.
